| Sub-region Integration Table Overview | Dr. Dyke | Sub-region Integration Table (SRIT) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To bring together health system and community partners and clinical leadership at the local level for health system planning and improvement - 10-15 members representing sectors - Meet monthly, immediately before the monthly PCA meetings - PCA co-chair participates on the SRIT and will ensure information flows between the PCA, SRIT, and broader primary care sector |
| Opioid Strategy | Dr. Dyke | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ontario is implementing a strategy to prevent addiction and overdose - HQO is developing an approach to support clinicians, starting with primary care clinicians |

| Medical Imaging Integrated Care Project | Dr. Dyke | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A project to find efficiencies and improve processes for patients - MRI is the first phase of this project - Optimize access to MRI services for patients --- a new Southwest LHIN wide MRI Requisition form has been created - New MRI Spine and Knee Checklist, endorsed by Choosing Wisely Canada - Available via fillable PDF, eMR compatible for Accuro, PS Suite, Oscar and NOD |
| Health Link / Coordinated Care Planning | Dr. Dyke | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Target population is people living with 4 or more chronic and/or high cost conditions - Multiple providers work collaboratively with the patient and their supports to develop patient-centered goals - Develop the Coordinated Care Plan (CCP) from this collaboration and goal setting |
| Clinical Connect | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - cSWO provided a demonstration of the clinicalconnect application - reduces duplication of documentation - improves the transitions in care - can be single sign-on from select HIS capabilities |
