What's new	Dr. Keith Dyke	<p>Please refer to PCA slide deck. Items highlighted include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Centre for Effective Practice will be providing resources to support academic detailing to physicians. Presently they have funded 1 FTE pharmacist • MSK Strategy for the LHIN overview • Bounce Back: a telephone-based program for people with mild to moderate mental illness • SOAHAC is looking for a physician in Grey Bruce • New MRI form: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Not all physicians are happy with new form ○ PS now has a pre-populated form available
Question/issues/concerns	All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health Human Resource recruitment continues to be a challenge in Grey Bruce • Concerns over turnover of home support health care providers and potential for errors/lack of education • Also when physician send a referral for a service like e-shift, they never hear back as to whether the service request was fulfilled – lack of communication increases risk to patient. Need a feedback loop • Also feels like a lack of communication between care coordinators across sub-regions. Again, increase risk that services are not provided or are incorrect • In summary – need to ensure physicians are in some sort of feedback loop when referring patients for home and community care.
