Supervised Consumption Facilities London Middlesex	Dr. Chris Mackie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dr. Neumann introduced Dr. Chris Mackie, Medical Officer of Health and CEO of the Middlesex London Health Unit Dr. Chris Mackie provided a presentation around drug use provincially and locally and the plan for both a temporary overdose prevention site and a longer-term supervised consumption site in LM The Business Improvement Areas asked the city to create specific zoning to make sure this service fits in well with official plan and other services that are available- Been working with Planning Department at the city to ensure they understand what is envisioned for this service City unanimously endorsed the initial phase of this work, and have recently endorsed the zoning policy that was developed - Temporary Overdose Prevention Site is planned to be open February 12
