Update on the London Sub-region	Dr. Schacter	<p>Opioid Strategy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TOPS – London Middlesex Temporary Opioid Prevention Site opened up • Have seen over 300 clients since it's opening in February • Minimal problems • Provides after care – to provide opportunity to discuss addiction with a worker • Plan to have permanent supervised consumption facilities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Has been announced – will be across from London Free Press building ○ Will be a permanent building that comes under federal exemption (can't get arrested for using their drug on site) ○ Goals – Harm Prevention, reduce HBV, HCV and HIV • Opioid Crisis Working Group members include patient advocate, primary care, police services, civic leaders, public health, mental health and addiction. • Academic Detailing by the Centre for Effective Practice is part of the opioid strategy <p>EMR Every Step Conference London April 12, 2018 "Pain, Opioids and the EMR"</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr. Gord Schacter presenting on "Pain, Opioids and the EMR" - understanding the EMR tools and fulfilling a minimum standard of care • Discussing management/use of opioid use for these patients <p>South West LHIN wide MRI requisition forms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Changes to the MRI forms • Forms changed in January to a new form • Just updated the form for <i>Telus Practice Solution</i> users further to make it more user friendly and speed up the form - now available on Primary Care Alliance Website • Currently working on CT Scan Form for the South West LHIN

Academic Detailing	Nicole Seymore & Lindsay Bevan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nicole Seymore and Lindsay Bevan from the Centre of Effective practice provided a presentation on academic detailing for family physicians (see presentation slide deck) • Centre of Effective Practice is a non-profit service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Currently offered to family physicians across 6 LHINs • Academic detailing provides family physicians with balance evidence based information on a number of primary care topics • Visits are certified by Ontario College of Family Physicians – for every visit you receive one credit <p>Questions/Comments/Feedback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receive funding from the Primary Care branch from the MOH • Currently providing visits with primary care and nurse practitioners • More of an interactive conversation/1-1
Transforming Musculoskeletal (MSK) Care in Ontario: A Comprehensive MSK Access to Care Program”	Andrea McInerney, Dr. Tatiana Jevremovic, Shirley Koch and Florence Cassar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Andrea McInerney, Manager Quality Improvement from the South West LHIN and Shirley Koch (Director, Huron Perth Sub-region) provided a high level overview of the MSK strategy (see presentation slide deck) • Initiative lines up with Patients First Act of 2016 <p>Questions/Comments/Feedback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need to look at Q1 and Q2, not Q3 which is the busiest time of the year in the hospital due to influenza • Feedback around surgical spine assessment referral/criteria – having specific criteria listed on form that physician can go through with patient to identify who would be a surgical candidate vs. who would not would be helpful • Initially plan to have assessment specialists assessing

		<p>hips/knees and spine separately but goal is to have specialists trained in both types of assessments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Novari will take fax based referral and put it into electronic system – because patient choice will be offered. Long term vision the system will prioritize patients based on referrals • With the MSK strategy assessment are we trying to address pain or function – intention would be for practitioners to address both between assessing and educating • MSK strategy is going to align with and support opioid strategy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Opioid education has to be a part of the strategy
