Please hold for 24 hours before the Pulmonary Function test if you are taking:? Advair, Anoro, Breo, Duaklir, Incruse,

Inspiolto, Onbrez, Oxeze (Formoterol), Seebri, Serevent, Spiriva (Tiotropium), Symbicort, Theo-dur, Tudorza, Uniphyll, Ultibro, Zenhale

METHACHOLINE CHALLENGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS - NO CAFFEINE OR ALCOHOL THE DAY OF THE TEST

Consumption of caffeine or use of puffers will result in the testing needing to be rescheduled

If you are taking any of the following medications please hold for the indicated amount of time prior to your Methacholine Challenge test.

Please hold for 8 hours before the Methacholine Challenge if you are taking:

Ventolin (Salbutamol, Airomir, Albutarol), Atrovent (Ipratropium), Bricanyl, Combivent

Please hold for 24 hours before the Methacholine Challenge if you are taking:

Accolate, Montelukast (Anti-leukotrienes), Singular, Allergy medication, ie. Claritin, Allegra

Please hold for 48 hours before the Methacholine Challenge if you are taking:

Advair, Alvesco, Anoro, Arnuity, Asmanex, Breo, Duaklir, Flovent (Fluticasone), Incruse, Inspiolto, Onbrez, Oxeze, Pulmicort (Budesonide), QVAR (Beclomethasone), Spiriva (Tiotropium), Seebri, Serevent (Salmeterol), Symbicort, Theo-dur, Tudorza, Ultibro, Uniphyll, Zenhale
